



## U18's Kubiak Selected 29<sup>th</sup> Overall by Green Bay Gamblers



The Chicago Fury is proud to announce that U18 forward Alex Kubiak has been selected by the Green Bay Gamblers of the USHL in the 3<sup>rd</sup> round of the 2009 USHL Entry Draft. The announcement was made by Fury Director of Player Development Nick Pollos.

The Tinley Park native also becomes the first forward from Illinois taken in this year's draft. The USHL is the only Tier I Junior A Hockey League in the United States. Earlier this season Kubiak gave his verbal commitment to NCAA DI Yale University for 2011. "I'm very proud of Alex and his selection in the USHL Draft by Green Bay" said Pollos, who coached Alex this past season for the Fury. "Alex did everything that was asked of him dating back to last summer starting with his off season training, and carried it right through to this season. Coach Copper in Green Bay is getting a player with tremendous skill, upside and character." Kubiak had this to say in a written statement about this opportunity in the USHL... "I can't thank coach Pollos enough for what he did for me, first with Yale and now with Green Bay and the USHL. This is one of the best feelings in the world. After meeting with the coaches and seeing the facility I couldn't be happier being drafted by Green Bay."

Kubiak becomes the first player in the short two year history of the Chicago Fury to be selected in the USHL Entry Draft.
