## **Fury's Carruth Named NAHL Showcase MVP**

Wenatchee goaltender **Mac Carruth**, a University of Minnesota Duluth (WCHA) recruit, was named the tournament's Most Valuable Player. The 17-year-old from Shorewood, Minn., fashioned a 3-0 record at the event, including a 21-save shutout over the Alexandria Blizzard on Wednesday, turning aside 74 of 76 shots. Carruth was also named to the All-Tournament Team.

"We're very happy and proud of Mac for receiving this award, and I think this early-season accomplishment is a direct result of the hard work he put in this summer," said McKelvie. "As one of our returning players, Mac has mentally matured and has evolved into one of our team leaders. I'm excited to see him improve throughout this season into a big-time goaltender."
