



Fury's Carruth Commits to WCHA Minnesota-Duluth Bulldogs

Chicago Fury Midget Major Goalie, Mac Carruth, has given his verbal commitment to The University of Minnesota-Duluth Bulldogs for the 2010 NCAA Hockey Season. The announcement was made by Fury Head Coach Nick Pollos.

After an unofficial visit to the UMD campus last week, the 1992 born Carruth felt right at home. The 15-year-old goalie from Shorewood, MN also was in contact with several other schools from the WCHA, CCHA and Hockey East but in the end, states Carruth, "UMD seemed like the perfect situation for me." Carruth emerged as the Fury's number one goalie as the season headed into the playoffs. He has some time before he will skate for the Bulldogs. Carruth will be in camp with the USNTDP U17 Team later this month as he competes for a spot on the USA Hockey National U17 team for next year.

"Mac is one of those special players who doesn't come along very often," said Fury coach Nick Pollos. "I think he's the best 15-year-old goalie in the country. He's big, athletic and covers a lot of the net as a strong butterfly goalie with good puck skills. Technically he's very good, very poised and tracks the puck very well." Pollos went on to add, "My Goalie Coach, Tim Anderson deserves allot of credit helping Mac develop this season, putting in extra time on the ice and off."

The Chicago Fury competes in the Mid West Elite Hockey League, considered the best Tier I AAA Hockey League in the United States.
